was a cold, crisp night filled with sounds of laughter and music when suddenly it was pierced by the shout of a lookout crying out, "Iceberg ahead." As warning bells sounded and panic ensued, "women and children first" were hustled into lifeboats and men were left on deck. The ship filled with water and broke in two. The maiden voyage of the Titanic was doomed. There were not enough life boats onboard, the crew did not know how to evacuate the passengers, and life boats were launched half-filled. Of the 2,224 passengers and crew onboard, over 1,500 souls were lost on that fateful night.

An event of catastrophic proportions in the history of the US, the sinking of the R.M.S. Titanic will be commemorated on this 104th anniversary. John W. W. Sherer presents an engaging program featuring organ music of 1912, music heard onboard the ship, and music written to honor the victims of the disaster. The program will include historical narrative and video clips.

Following the program, *Artist Circle ticket holders are invited to a dessert reception in the "Captain's Dining Room," where you will have the opportunity to meet Mr. Sherer. In addition, guests will enjoy entertainment as might have been experienced while onboard the Titanic.

Net proceeds from this concert will benefit New Covenant's Youth Missions Teams. The High School students will travel to Chattanooga, Tennessee in June and the Middle School

youth will travel to Savannah, Georgia in July. Both groups will be part of "Youthworks" and will have opportunities to feed the homeless, sort food for the hungry, interact with disabled persons, communicate with nursing home residents, and build diverse bonds and friendships.
